Obtain your Alberta driver's licenses, Insurance coverage and Registration ALL at one location at one time. We have two registries in South Edmonton, as well as four insurance brokerages to serve you.

You will require ID for all of the following. Acceptable ID.

1. Phone your previous *provincial insurance carrier* to obtain a driver abstract and insurance claims

experience letter. Note that if you were previously insured with a private insurance company you

should contact your prior brokerage. These documents are required *before* Alberta insurance can be

put in force.

2. Obtain an insurance quote from an All Insurance office, give us a call so we know to expect documents

from you. Email or Fax are both acceptable

3. At our Registries office:

a. Obtain an Alberta driver's license.

b. Request an Out-of-Province Inspection form.

4. We can complete an application of insurance for you, after giving you a quote; the process is definitely

a little easier if you have an Alberta Driver's License, but if you haven't obtained it yet, we can still

insure you.

5. Return to our Registries office to register your vehicle. Bring with you the following:

a. Valid Out-of-Province Inspection form.

b. Proof of Alberta Insurance.

c. Vehicle registration from previous province (you must bring this in again).

d. All parties listed on registration must sign.

6. If you have any questions or concerns, or have a hard time getting your claims experience letter, give

us a call and we can definitely advise you regarding any of the above.
